SCARLET DAY OF SERVICE

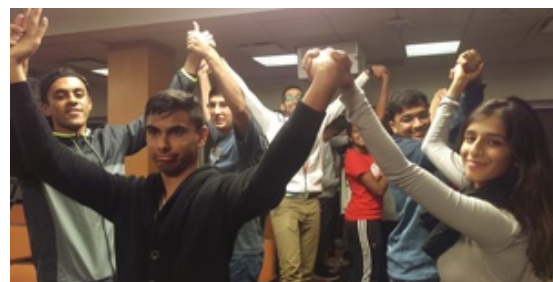
